

## CHAPTER OLIV.

March 7, 1867. *An act for the relief of John H. McKenzie and Onesime Giguere.*

SECTION 1.—Appropriates money for services rendered in capture of Indians  
2.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Appropriation

SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand dollars be appropriated out of any money in the treasury of this state, not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse and pay John H. McKenzie and Onesime Giguere for moneys expended and services rendered by them in the capture of the Indian chiefs Little Six and Grey Iron.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
