CHAPTER OLVII.

An Act making appropriations for expenses of N. March 8, 1867 Richardson in contested election case.

Section 1—Appropriation for contested election case. 2.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sum of money be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated:

To N. Richardson, for moneys expended by him for justices' fees, expense of witnesses, &c., in the contested election case of Richardson vs. Hæpner, ninetyone dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER OLVIIL

An Act to appropriate money for certain purposes March 1, 1867 therein named.

BROMON 1—Appropriates various amounts to parties therein named for attendance on Norwegian emigrants.

SPECIAL LAWS

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, not otherwise appropriated :

1st. To Dr. T. M. Everts, for medical services rendered sick and destitute Norwegian emigrants attacked with cholera, thirty-three dollars and seventy-eight cents.

2nd. To O. J. Johnson, for goods and medicines furnished said emigrants, thirty-four dollars.

3rd. To Swen Hesesson, for nursing and care of said emigrants eight days, forty dollars.

4th. To Ohristian Sosenson, nursing and care of said emigrants, eight days, sixteen dollars.

5th. To Dr. Sone Knutson, for attendance upon and medicine for said emigrants, seventy-two dollars.

6th. To Bodam and Beaurman, for fifteen coffins for said emigrants, eighty-nine dollars.

7th. To Dr. R. W. Twitchell, for medical attendance upon and medicine for said emigrants, twenty-five dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
