

CHAPTER II.

An Act to authorize the St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company to construct a Branch Road from Wabashaw to the Southern boundary of the State of Minnesota: March 7, 1867.

SECTION 1.—Authorizes the St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company to construct a certain road.

2—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The Saint Paul and Pacific Railroad Company are hereby authorized to survey, construct, operate and maintain, under provisions and restrictions of their charter, a branch road from Wabashaw, by the way of Plainview, Elgin, Rochester, High Forest, Brownsdale, Austin and Albert Lea, to the southern boundary of the state in the direction of Omaha in the state of Nebraska. Establishes a
branch road.

SEC. 2. This act is hereby declared to be a public act and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. To be a public
act.
