

## CHAPTER XXV.

*An Act to amend an Act entitled "An Act to incorporate the city of Minneapolis."*

March 7, 1867

**SECTION 1.**—Boundaries of town of Minneapolis—election of officers therefor.

2.—What officers to retain office.

3.—Repeals inconsistent acts.

4.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

**SECTION 1.** That the territory embraced within the township of Brighton, as said township is established by act of the legislature of said state, entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Minneapolis," together with sections sixteen to twenty-one, inclusive of township one hundred and seventeen north, of range twenty-one west, and sections one to twelve, inclusive of township twenty-eight north, of range twenty-four west, and the east half of section twenty-eight of township twenty-nine north, of range twenty-four west, and the east half of the north-east quarter of the north-east quarter of section thirty-six, and the east half of lot four of section twenty-five, all in township twenty-nine north, of range twenty-four west, and lot three in section thirty, and lots five and six in section thirty-one of township twenty-nine north, of range twenty-three west, and sections six and seven, and so much of sections five and eight as lie west of the centre of the Mississippi river, and so much of section eighteen as lies north of the Minnehaha creek, and so much of section seventeen as lies north of Minnehaha creek and west of the Mississippi river, all in township twenty-eight north, of range twenty-three west, be, and the same hereby shall constitute and be organized as a separate township by the name of Minneapolis, and may, in the manner provided by statute, elect their township officers on the first Tuesday of April, A. D. 1867.

Boundaries

Officers to continue

SEC. 2. The supervisors and other officers of the present town of Brighton, as constituted by said act of the legislature entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Minneapolis," shall continue to hold their respective offices in the proposed township of Minneapolis until other officers are elected and qualified.

Repeals conflicting acts

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XXVI.

March 6, 1867.

*An Act to amend an act entitled An Act to incorporate the City of Hastings, and to repeal its former charter.*

SECTION 1.—Amends section 9, chapter 3, of incorporation act, by prescribing duties of city marshal

2.—Strikes out certain words in original act.

3.—Amends first of section 2 of original act.

4.—Further amendment of incorporation act.

5.—Division of city into wards.

6.—Defines who shall be elected officers.

7.—Term of office of elective officers.

8.—Powers to levy tax.

9.—Repeals conflicting acts.
