

CHAPTER III.

March 7, 1867. *An Act to authorize the Minnesota Valley Railroad Company to construct a Branch from Henderson, in the County of Sibley, or some point North of that place, on the main line of said Road, to the West line of the State.*

SECTION 1.—Minnesota Valley Railroad authorized to construct branch road.

2.—Laws in force governing Minnesota Valley Railroad to be extended.

3.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Establishes a
branch road.

SECTION 1. That the Minnesota Valley Railroad Company is hereby authorized to survey, locate and construct a branch railroad from its main line at Henderson, in the county of Sibley, or some point on the main line of said railroad, north of Henderson aforesaid, running thence west by the most practicable route to the west line of this state.

Original charter
to remain in force

SEC. 2. That the laws now in force relating to the construction and operating, and all the provisions of the charter of the Minnesota Valley Railroad Company, so far as applicable, necessary and convenient, shall be extended to and be in force for the construction and operation of the branch road authorized by this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
