

## CHAPTER XXXVI.

*An Act to extend the limits of the Town of Du Luth  
in the County of St. Louis.*March 9, 1867

SECTION 1.—Extends boundaries of town of DuLuth.

2.—When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the boundaries of the town of Du Luth, in the county of St. Louis, are hereby extended to embrace within the limits of said town the following tracts, viz: Lot number three (3) in section number twenty three, (23) and the south-west quarter and west half of the south-east quarter of section number twenty-two (22), and the north west quarter of section twenty-seven (27), fractional south-west quarter, and fractional north east quarter, and fractional south-east quarter of said section twenty-seven (27), and fractional north-west quarter, being lot three (3) of section thirty-four, all in town fifty (50) north, of range fourteen west in said county.

Boundaries

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
