

CHAPTER IV.

An Act to authorize the Winona and Saint Peter Railroad Company to endorse the bonds of the La Crosse, Trempeleau and Prescott Railroad Company.

February 19, 1867

SECTION 1.—Empowers Saint Peter Railroad Company to assume payment of certain bonds.

2.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The Winona and Saint Peter Railroad Company are hereby authorized and empowered to indorse, guarantee or assume the payment of the principal and interest of each and every of the bonds of the La Crosse, Trempeleau and Prescott Railroad Company, either severally or jointly with the Milwaukee and Saint Paul Railway Company, to an amount not exceeding in the aggregate one million dollars.

Company may assume payment of bonds.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

An Act extending the time for the completion of the Lake Superior and Mississippi Railroad.

March 8, 1867.
