CHAPTER XLVI.

Harch 4, 1867 An Act to authorize the electors of the town of Warsaw in Goodhue county, to raise a tax to pay unredeemed bounty orders, and to legalize the tax heretofore levied for that purpose.

Szomow I.—Provides for the redemption of bounty orders.

2.—Legalizes action of voters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Provision for bounty orders Secrion 1. That the legal voters of the town of Warsaw, in Goodhue county, Minnesota, may at their annual town meeting, have power to vote to raise such sums of money as they may deem necessary to pay unredeemed "bounty orders" of said town, and the county auditor of Goodhue county shall extend upon the tax list of said town the amount so voted to be raised.

Legalises action

SEC. 2. That the action of the legal voters of said town heretofore had for the purpose aforesaid is hereby declared to be legal and valid to all intents and purposes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
