

CHAPTER LXVII.

*An Act to legalize the issuing of bonds by commissioners of Benton county.*March 9, 1867.

SECTION 1.—Commissioners may issue bonds.

2.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the bonds issued by the commissioners of Benton county during the year 1866, for the purpose of erecting county buildings for county purposes, at Sauk Rapids, in said county, be and the same are hereby legalized and made valid to all intents and purposes.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
