

a claim against said county or bridge, except to the extent of its *pro rata* share of interest as aforesaid: *And provided further*, That in case such tolls shall exceed in amount the sum required for such costs, expenses and interest, such surplus shall be applied in payment of said certificates and bonds *pro rata*.

SEC. 6. Said bridge shall be the property of the county of Ramsey, and to enable said county to maintain said bridge and keep the same in repair, as well as to furnish a fund for the payment of the interest on said bonds and certificates, the said county is hereby authorized to levy and collect tolls upon said bridge, not to exceed the rates following, viz:

Bridge to belong
to county—tolls

For each foot passage, ten cents; for each horse, mare or mule, or two-ox team, loaded or unloaded, with driver, twenty-five cents; for each single horse carriage twenty-five cents; for each additional cow or ox, ten cents; for each swine or sheep two cents.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXVII

An Act relative to bathing in Lake Como in the county of Ramsey.

March 5, 1867

SECTION 1.—Prohibits bathing in Lake Como at certain times.

2.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. No person shall swim or bathe in Lake Como, in the county of Ramsey, between the hours of six o'clock, A. M., and eight o'clock, P. M. Any person violating the provisions of this act, shall, upon con-

viction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding twenty-five dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXVIII.

March 2, 1867

An Act to legalize the election of county officers of Renville county.

SECTION 1.—Confirms election held in Renville county.

2.—Boundaries of county defined.

3.—Designates legal officers of county.

4.—When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Ratifies election

SECTION 1. That the election held in Renville county, on the eighth day of November, 1866, for the election of county officers for said county is hereby confirmed and ratified, and said officers, until their successors are elected and qualified, shall have full power and authority to do and perform all acts and duties of their respective offices within the limits of Renville county as hereafter defined.

Boundaries

SEC. 2. The county of Renville is established and bounded as follows: Beginning in the middle of the main channel of the Minnesota river, on the line between townships one hundred and seventeen, and one hundred and eighteen north, on the fifth principal meridian; thence east on said township line to the line between ranges thirty six and thirty-seven; thence south on said range line to the line between townships one hundred and sixteen, and one hundred and
