

48th.—For mileage of county treasurers, and express charges on state funds, five hundred dollars [\$500].

49th.—For the publication and distribution of immigration pamphlets and incidental expenses of such publication and distribution, three thousand dollars [\$3,000].

50th.—For fuel and lights for both houses of the legislature and the several state offices, fifteen hundred dollars [\$1,500].

51st.—For repairs of state capitol, two thousand dollars [\$2,000].

52nd.—For rent of state arsenal, four hundred dollars [\$400].

53d.—For expense incurred by the purchase of one dozen chairs for the use of the senate, twenty-eight dollars [\$28].

54th.—For the purchase of additional copies of volumes three, four, five, six, seven and eight of Minnesota supreme court reports, four hundred dollars [\$400].

55th.—For stationery and newspapers for the members of the senate of the present legislature, nine hundred and sixty-three dollars and thirty cents.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXIV.

An Act appropriating money to defray the expenses incurred in the treatment of certain indigent soldiers and other persons, at the "Eye and Ear Infirmary" in Chicago, Illinois.

February 23, 1868

SECTION 1. Appropriation to defray the expenses incurred in the treatment of indigent soldiers at the Eye and Ear Infirmary.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars, or

so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, and placed at the disposal of the governor, to be expended in maintaining, at the "Eye and Ear Infirmary" in Chicago, Illinois, any indigent soldiers, or others, of this state who may be suffering from diseases of the eye or ear.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXV.

February 27, 1868

An Act to appropriate the sum of five hundred dollars to aid in the apprehension of the murderer of Frederick Ableitner.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for the purpose of apprehending the murderer of Frederick Ableitner.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five hundred dollars, for the purpose of apprehending a man by the name of Edwards, charged with the murder of Frederick Ableitner, in Olmsted county, in October last, said moneys or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be paid out under the direction of the governor.

When act to take

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
