March 5, 1868.

An Act for the relief of H. Wilson.

- SECTION 1. When Auditor authorized to issue duplicate warrant.
 - Before receiving said duplicate to file bond—in what sum.
 - When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

When Auditor authorized to issue duplicate warrant.

Section 1. Upon receiving satisfactory evidence of the loss of a certain state warrant for the sum of one thousand six hundred and seven dollars and thirty-eight cents, numbered [1,497] fourteen hundred and ninty-seven, and issued January sixteenth [16th], eighteen hundred and sixty-eight [1868], in favor of H. Wilson, treasurer, and being for current expenses of the state deaf, dumb and blind institute, the state auditor is hereby authorized and required to issue a duplicate of said state warrant to the said H. Wilson, treasurer.

what sum.

The said H. Wilson shall before receiving SEC. 2. To file bond-in said duplicate, file a bond equal to the amount of said lost warrant with the state auditor, to be approved by the governor of the state. Provided, If said lost warrant shall be returned to the state then the said bond to be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect, as an indemnity to the state against any future liability to pay the said lost warrant.

When act to take effect.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
