

Upon what conditions to be paid.

wise held or owned by the said Minnesota state reform school; and the execution of said conveyance shall be deemed a full assent to and acceptance on the part of the state reform school of all the provisions of this act; *Provided*, That no money shall be drawn from the state treasury until said conveyance is made to the state.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 3. That so much of the act entitled an act to incorporate a house of refuge for the state of Minnesota, approved March first, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, and of the acts amendatory thereof, as may be inconsistent with the provisions of this act is hereby repealed.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XVII.

March 6, 1868.

An Act to amend Chapter thirty-five (35) of the General Statutes, relating to Charitable Institutions.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section 19, Chapter 35. The Board of Directors shall annually elect a President, Secretary and Treasurer, also a Steward.
2. Amendment to Section 21, Chapter 35. Duties of Treasurer.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section nineteen (19), of chapter thirty-five (35), of the general statutes of Minnesota, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Annual election of officers.

Sec. 19. Said board of directors shall annually elect from their own number a president, secretary and treasurer, and they shall also annually elect a steward, who may or may not be of their own number, and whose compensation shall be fixed by the said board.

SEC. 2. Section twenty-one (21), of said chapter is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 21. The treasurer shall safely keep, and faithfully disburse, all moneys belonging to or intrusted to said institution, shall render an exact and detailed account of expenditures on the first day of December in each year to said board, and whenever said board require; and shall perform all other duties required by the directors, according to the rules and regulations established by said board, and shall receive for his services a compensation to be fixed by said board not exceeding one hundred dollars per year.

Duties of Treasurer.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.

CHAPTER XVIII.

An Act to amend an act entitled an act for the establishment and location of a Hospital for the Insane in the State of Minnesota, and to provide rules for the regulation of the same, approved March second, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, and to repeal chapter eleven, of the session laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, approved March ninth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section 4, Chapter 6, Laws of 1866. Hospital to be known by title of "Minnesota Hospital for Insane"—seven trustees appointed—four to constitute quorum.
2. Amendment to Section 8, Chapter 6. Appropriations made for benefit of insane, to be expended by and paid upon order of Board.
3. Amendment to Section 10, Chapter 6. Trustees to take oath to support the Constitution, and faithfully discharge their duties—to be paid their expenses during time engaged in official duty—when and where annual meetings to be held—President, Secretary and Treasurer to be elected—term of service.
