## CHAPTER XXXIV.

March 4, 1868.

An Act to amend Section three, of Chapter forty-seven, of the Session Laws of 1867, entitled an act for the adjustment of certain tax accounts between the State of Minnesota and certain counties therein.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section 3, Chapter 47, Session Laws of 1867. Twenty-five per cent. allowed on all sums paid previous to January 1, 1869—one-half to be paid previous to July 1, 1863.
  - 2. When not to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section three, of chapter forty-seven, be ammended so as to read as follows:

What percentage allowed. Sec. 3. The state auditor is hereby required to allow twenty-five per cent. on all sums paid on said indebtedness, previous to the first day of January, 1869, and to allow all abatements of taxes heretofore made in accordance with law: Provided, however, That one half of said indebtedness shall be paid on or before the first day of July, 1868.

when act to take SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
