## CHAPTER XCVI.

An Act to amend section five, of chapter seventy, of the General Statutes, entitled "Fees."

March 5, 1868.

Section 1. Amendment to Section 6, Chapter 70, General Statutes. Fees allowed Judge of Probate.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section five, of chapter seventy, of the general statutes, be amended by adding to the end thereof the following:

For all services required to be performed by judges of Feet allowed probate, for which compensation is not herein provided Judge of Protor, such fees as are now allowed to the clerks of the district court for like services

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to take and after its passage.
