JOINT RESOLUTIONS.

PASSED AND APPROVED AT THE TENTH SESSION OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE, COMMENCING JANUARY SEVENTH, ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT, AND TERMINATING MARCH SIXTH, ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT.

NUMBER I.

Joint Resolution of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, to authorize the Land Commissioner to appoint deputies to sell Lands in certain Counties.

March 6, 1868.

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Resolved, That the land commissioner of this state be and he is hereby authorized to appoint a deputy for the sale of school lands remaining unsold in the counties of Carver, Dakota, Dodge, Fillmore, Goodhue, Houston, Olmsted, Rice, Wabashaw, Washington and Winona.

To authorize the Land Commissioner to appoint deputies.

And be it further resolved, That such deputy, before entering upon the duties of his office, shall take and subscribe the oath prescribed by law to be taken and subscribed by the said land commissioner, and shall enter into bonds with one or more sureties, to be approved by the governor, in the sum of ten thousand dollars, payable to the state of Minnesota, conditioned for the faithful discharge of his official duties, which oath and bond shall be deposited in the office of the secretary of state.

To take oath and give bonds.

And be it further resolved, That such sales shall be conducted in all respects as is now provided by chapter thirty-eight (33), of the general statutes.

How sales shall be conducted.
