

Duty of Governor in case this act is adopted:

returns upon said question, in the same manner and at the same time as returns of county officers, and the abstract thereof shall be made on one sheet, and signed and certified in the same manner as in the case of the abstract of votes for said officers, and shall be deposited in the county auditor's office immediately thereafter, and a copy thereof duly certified by the auditor, forwarded by him to the secretary of state, and the governor shall thereupon forthwith, if this law is adopted, make proclamation to that effect, in such manner as he shall deem advisable.

Donations to be deposited with Treasurer.

SEC. 6. It shall be lawful for any citizen or citizens of said county to deposit any sum of money or bonds, deeds or mortgages with the county treasurer, which they may propose to donate for a site or the erection of county buildings at the village of Farmington or city of Hastings.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force after its submission to the electors of said county, at the next general election after the passage hereof, and its adoption by a majority of such electors voting on the same. And in case the same is adopted, all officers who are required to hold their offices at the county seat, shall within sixty days after such adoption move and hold their offices at said village of Farmington.

## CHAPTER CXII.

February 7, 1868.

*An Act to to legalize certain proceedings of the County Commissioners of Sherburne county, in eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and the election of certain officers of such county.*

- SECTION 1. Proceedings of County Commissioners with the intention of re-districting such county legalized.
2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That all the proceedings of the county of

commissioners of the county of Sherburne, in the state of Minnesota, for the purpose and with the intention of redistricting such county, in the month of June of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six, and all official acts and proceedings affected by such redistricting, be and the same hereby are legalized and made valid to all intents and purposes, and shall and do have the same force and effect as though such proceedings had been in strict conformity to the provisions of the law, made and provided for the redistricting of counties into districts, equal to the number of members constituting the board of commissioners of such counties respectively, and that all elections of county officers of said county of Sherburne, since such proceedings and before the passage of this act, be and the same hereby are in all respects legalized and made valid.

### CHAPTER CXIII.

#### *An Act to locate the county seat of Chippewa county.*

March 6, 1868.

SECTION 1. Temporary location of county seat.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The county seat of Chippewa county is hereby temporarily located at Chippewa city, in said county.
