

CHAPTER CXXIV.

February 27, 1868 *An Act to change the name of the town of "Empire city" to that of "Empire," in Dakota county.*

- SECTION 1. Change of name of said town.
 2. Not to affect the rights and privileges of said town or any citizen thereof.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Change of name of said town. SECTION 1. That the name of the town of "Empire City" in Dakota county, be and the same is hereby changed to that of "Empire."

Not to affect the rights of said town or citizens thereof. SEC. 2. That the change of said name shall in no manner affect the right, privileges and immunities of said town, or of any citizen thereof, or citizens of said state, or any other person or persons whatever, but said town shall proceed under the new name as under the old name.

When act to take effect. SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXV.

March 5, 1869. *An Act to repeal chapter one hundred and forty-six (146), of special session laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven (1867).*

- SECTION 1. Repeal of former Chapter.
 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter one hundred and forty-six

(146), of special session laws relating to the change of name of the town of Wayzata, in the county of Hennepin, is hereby repealed and the name of Wayzata reinstated. Repeal of former Chapter.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER CXXVI.

An Act to repeal so much of section five (5), of chapter one hundred and nineteen (119), of the special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty six (1866), which changes the name of Annie Astellia Baker to Annie Astellia Clure, and constituting her heir at law of Charles Clure and Mary Jane Clure. February 18, 1868

SECTION 1. Repeal of former act.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That so much of section five (5), of chapter one hundred and nineteen (119), of the special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-six (1866), which changes the name of Annie Astellia Baker to Annie Astellia Clure, and constituting her heir at law of Charles Clure and Mary Jane Clure, be and the same is hereby repealed. Repeal of former act.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
