

CHAPTER CXXX.

February 17, 1868

An Act to restore James Meredith to citizenship.

SECTION 1. Restoration to citizenship.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Restored to citizenship.

SECTION 1. That James Meredith of the town of Marine, Washington county, be and hereby is restored to citizenship, with all the rights and privileges granted to a citizen, under the constitution of the state of Minnesota.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXXI.

February 14, 1868

An Act to authorize the guardian of J. Willis Bunker and Robert Bunker, Jr., to sell real estate at private sale.

SECTION 1. Guardian of said heirs authorized to sell and dispose of real estate at private sale.

2. Shares of purchase money received to be held in trust to the use of said minor heirs—right of dower of said widow.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the real estate of which Robert Bunker,

late of Hennepin county, deceased, intestate, died seized and which has heretofore been duly assigned by the judge of Probate of Hennepin county, to J. Willis Bunker and Robert Bunker, Jr., heirs of Robert Bunker, deceased, may be bargained, sold and conveyed at private sale, by Reuben Butters, guardian of the aforesaid J. Willis Bunker and Robert Bunker, Jr., minor heirs as aforesaid, and Emilie J. Ellingson, formerly widow of the deceased, joining in a deed or deeds of conveyance thereof. The sale or sales of said lands or real estate to be subject to the order and ratification of the judge of probate of Hennepin county, and such length of time for the payment of the purchase money be given, as will in the judgment of the said court be for the interest of all parties concerned. The consideration or purchase money for which such conveyance shall be made, shall be apportioned among the aforesaid heirs and widow according to law.

To sell real estate at private sale.

SEC. 2. The shares of the said purchase money received by the guardian of said minor heirs shall be held in trust to the use of said minor heirs as in other cases of guardianship. The share of such purchase money received by the widow of said deceased shall be in full satisfaction and discharge of her right of dower in and to such real estate.

Shares to be held in trust for minor heirs—right of dower of said widow.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
