

CHAPTER CXXXIII.

*An Act to authorize the Commissioners of certain State
Roads to appraise damages.*

March 5, 1868.

SECTION 1. In whom authority vested to appraise damages sustained—appeals may be taken.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the commissioners appointed by an act entitled "an act to locate a state road from Lake City, in Wabasha county, via Plainview to St. Charles, in Winona county," and the commissioners appointed by an act entitled "an act for the location of a state road from Lake City in Wabasha county via Pell and Elgin to Eyota, in Olmsted county, are hereby authorized and it shall be their duty to appraise and determine all damages sustained by each owner of land through which the respective roads may pass, and file the appraisal of the same in the office of the county auditor in the county in which such land so appraised is situated and in case any one shall feel aggrieved by such appraisal he may appeal to the county commissioners of his county within thirty, (30), days after such appraisal has been filed and thereupon the county commissioners shall at their next regular meeting proceed to hear and determine said appeal and decide the same as they shall deem just and right.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
