CHAPTER CXLVII.

March 5, 1868.

An act to locate a state road from Waseca, Waseca county, to Albert Lea, in the county of Freeborn.

- SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed to locate State Road.
2. When and where to meet.
 3. May employ surveyor, &c.—compensation.
 4. How expenses of locating said road to be defrayed.
 5. Damages sustained, how ascertained.
 6. Commissioners to file plat of road.
 7. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To locate State road.

SECTION 1. B. A. Lowell, H. G. Mosher and Andrew Samson are hereby appointed commissioners to locate a state road, commencing about one mile east of the village of Waseca, in Waseca county, where the Winona and St. Peter Railway crosses the road leading from the centre of the town of Otisco in said Waseca county, to said village of Waseca, thence south through the towns of Otisco and Richland, Waseca county, one half of a mile east of the center of said towns of Otisco and Richland, as near as practicable to Albert Lea, in the county of Freeborn.

When and where to meet.

SEC. 2. Said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall meet at said village of Waseca at a time not later than the first day of August next, and proceed to discharge their duties under this act.

May employ surveyor, &c.—compensation.

SEC. 3. Said commissioners are hereby empowered to employ one chainman, one axman and a competent surveyor. *Provided*, That neither of said commissioners,

axman or chainman shall receive more than one dollar and fifty cents per day for the time necessarily occupied in the location of said road, nor the surveyor more than three dollars per day for his services under this act.

SEC. 4. The expense of locating said road shall be paid by the counties of Waseca and Freeborn, in proportion to the length of said road in said counties. How expenses defrayed.

SEC. 5. It shall be the duty of the commissioners to appraise the damages sustained by each owner of land through which said road may pass, and in case any one shall feel himself aggrieved by such appraisal, he may appeal to the county commissioners of his county at any time within thirty days thereafter, and said county commissioners shall at their next annual meeting hear and determine said appeal as they shall deem just. Damages, how ascertained.

SEC. 6. Said commissioners shall, on or before the 1st day of September next, file an accurate plat of said road in the office of the register of deeds of the counties of Waseca and Freeborn, and thereafter said road shall be deemed established. To file plat of road.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
