

## CHAPTER XLIII.

*An Act to amend section one, of chapter seventy-two, of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, amending the charter of the city of Hastings.*

March 6, 1868.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section 1, Chapter 72, Special Laws 1862. What property subject to taxation.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section one, of chapter seventy-two, of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 1. All property, real and personal, within the city of Hastings, except such as may be exempt by the laws of this state, shall be subject to taxation for the purposes hereinafter provided. And the city council of the city of Hastings are hereby authorized to levy a tax on all of the taxable property of said city for general city purposes, to an amount not exceeding two and one half mills on the dollar in any one year, and in addition thereto a sum sufficient to maintain a free ferry across the Mississippi river at said city. All qualified voters shall be liable to a poll tax not exceeding one dollar in any one year to be levied by the city council.

What property to be taxed.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
