lays north and west of Phelps street, in the city of Wabasha, is hereby created into a special school district, to be governed by the general laws of schools in and for the state of Minnesota.

Sec. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to take and after its passage.

CHAPTER LVII.

An Act to authorize the board of county commissioners of the county of Wabasha to change the boundaries of school district number thirty, and to form a new district.

March 5, 1868.

SECTION 1. Board of County Commissioners authorized to alter the boundary line of School District number thirty.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the board of county commissioners of the county of Wabasha, be and the same are hereby May alter the authorized and empowered at any time before the first boundary of day of September, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, to number thirty. alter the boundary line of school district number thirty (30), in Wabasha county, or to form a new school district from any part of said school district number thirty (30), and of any territory adjoining said district, upon application in writing signed by five legal voters living within said school district number thirty, or the new school district to be formed from said school district number thirty, and adjoining territory.

When act totake SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and atter its passage.

CHAPTER LVIII.

Februa'v I. 1868.

An Act to legalize the action of a Special Meeting of the Saint Charles School District in the County of Winona, held January eleventh A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.

SECTION 1. Action of a special meeting held authorizing the issue of bonds legalized.

2. When act to take effect. .

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Action of special meeting legalized,

Section 1. That the action of a special meeting of the St. Charles school district, in the county of Winona, held January eleventh, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, in voting to raise the sum of three thousand dollars as a tax on the taxable property of the said district, and to issue the bonds of the said district for the same, for the purpose of building a school house in the said district, be and the same are hereby legalized and declared valid, and the levy and collection of a tax for the payment of the principal and interest of said bonds shall be legal and binding upon the said district, the same as if the issue of said bonds had been fully authorized by law, and said tax shall be collected in the same manner as other district taxes are now collected.
