

CHAPTER LXXIV.

March 4, 1868.

An Act to provide for the levy and collection of the tax voted by the voters of School District number one (1), in Douglas County, for eighteen hundred and sixty-seven (1867).

SECTION 1. Clerk of school district to make statement to County Auditor—what to contain—duties of Auditor.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To report to Auditor—what report to contain—duty of Auditor.

SECTION 1. The clerk of school district number one (1), in the county of Douglas, which said district is composed of territory belonging in part to said county and in part to Todd county, shall immediately upon the passage of this act certify and return to the auditors of said counties a statement of the amount of tax voted to be raised by the voters of said district in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven (1867), for school purposes, and the said auditors shall thereupon forthwith proceed to levy the amount required upon the taxable property in that part of the district in their respective counties according to the provisions of section five (5), of chapter thirty-six (36), of the general statutes, and the same shall be collected in the same manner as other taxes for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven (1867), remaining unpaid at the time of the passage of this act are required to be collected.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
