CHAPTER LXXXV.

An Act to legalize the issue of certain town orders by the town of Langola, in the County of Benton.

March 6, 1868.

- SECTION 1. Legalization of certain orders issued by said town.
 2. Special tax to be levied for the purpose of paying said orders.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That certain town orders to the amount of one thousand dollars, bearing ten per cent. interest dated November twenty ninth (29th), eighteen hundred and sixty-seven (1867), issued by the town of Langola, in the county of Benton, to aid in the construction of a bridge across the Platt River, be and the same are hereby legalized and made valid and binding. Orders legalized

Sec. 2. That a special tax shall be levied upon the taxable property of said town, to pay the said orders, and shall be collected with the other taxes of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight (1868). Special tax levied to pay said orders.
