

CHAPTER LXXXVI.

March 6, 1868. *An Act to authorize the issue of interest bearing orders by the town of Watab.*

- SECTION 1. Board of Supervisors of said town authorized to issue orders—in what amount—for what purpose.
2. Special tax to be levied for the purpose of paying said orders.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To issue orders
—in what sums
—for what purpose.

SECTION 1. That the board of supervisors of the town of Watab in the county of Benton be, and they hereby are authorized to issue orders to the amount of three hundred dollars, and bearing interest at the rate of ten per cent. to aid in the construction of a bridge across Little Rock Creek.

Special tax for paying the same

SEC. 2. That a special tax shall be levied upon the taxable property of said town, and collected with other taxes of said town for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-eight (1868).

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
