

CHAPTER CVI.

An Act to appropriate Money for certain purposes therein named. March 5, 1869.

SECTION 1. Appropriations from the General Revenue Fund:

1. To Lucien Warner for reward offered and other expenses incurred in the arrest of Horatio Robinson.
2. To proprietor Sawyer House, expenses of Legislative committee for 1869.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money, be, and the same are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated, viz:

First—To Lucien Warner for reward paid and other expense incurred in the arrest of Horatio Robinson, six hundred and seven dollars (\$607). To Lucien Warner.

Second—To proprietor of Sawyer House for entertaining legislative committee in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, one hundred and five dollars (\$105). To proprietor Sawyer House.
