

## CHAPTER XIV.

March 5, 1869. *An Act to appropriate money for the erection of additional buildings for the Institute for the Deaf and Dumb and Blind.*

SECTION 1. Appropriation for the purpose of laying the foundation stones of the south wing of the Deaf and Dumb, and the Blind Institute.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

For foundation  
of Deaf, Dumb  
and Blind In-  
stitute.

SECTION 1. That the sum of ten thousand dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of laying the foundations of the south wing of the institute according to the plans heretofore adopted, and for building a cooper shop, and otherwise preparing accommodations for the inmates of the institute for the deaf, dumb and blind, as the commissioners may deem necessary.

When act to  
take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
