CHAPTER XXVI.

An Act to amend Section two, of Chapter sixty-eight, of the March 4, 1869. General Statutes, relating to Homestead Exemption.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section two (9) of Chapter sixty-eight (68) of the General Statutes. Exemption not to extend to any lien for work done or material furnished for the erection of buildings.

When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two, of chapter sixty-eight, of the general statutes, relating to homestead exemption, Exemption not be amended by adding to said section two the following: to extend to like And such exemption shall not extend to any contract for terial furnished. a lien, or upon which a lien would arise under the lien laws of this state, for work done or material furnished in the erection or repair of a dwelling house or other building on said land.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from when set to take effect. and after its approval by the governor.
