

CHAPTER XXVI.

An Act to amend Section two, of Chapter sixty-eight, of the General Statutes, relating to Homestead Exemption. March 4, 1869.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section two (2) of Chapter sixty-eight (68) of the General Statutes. Exemption not to extend to any lien for work done or material furnished for the erection of buildings.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two, of chapter sixty-eight, of the general statutes, relating to homestead exemption, be amended by adding to said section two the following: And such exemption shall not extend to any contract for a lien, or upon which a lien would arise under the lien laws of this state, for work done or material furnished in the erection or repair of a dwelling house or other building on said land.

Exemption not to extend to lien for work or material furnished.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

When act to take effect.
