

CHAPTER XLVIII.

An Act to amend Section thirty-two of Chapter forty-six of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, relating to the General Statutes and their distribution. March 5, 1869.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section thirty-two (32) of Chapter forty-six (46) of the General Laws of 1863. Secretary of State custodian of the General Statutes.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section thirty-two of chapter forty-six of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following to the last clause of said section: The secretary of state is also hereby declared the custodian of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six. He shall carefully preserve the same for the use of the state, delivering to each unorganized county two copies, and to the governor such number of copies as shall be necessary to supply one copy to each state and territory of the United States and each department of the general government.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
