CHAPTER LVIII.

An Act to amend Section twenty-nine, of Chapter sixty-six March 5, 1869. of the General Statutes, relative to parties to civil actions.

> SECTION I. Amendment to Section twenty-nine (29) of Chapter sixty-six (66) of the General Statutes. A married woman may sue or be sued without joining her busband.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twenty-nine, of chapter sixtysix, of the general statutes, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 29. A married woman may sue or be sued as if unmarried, and without joining her husband, in all cases where the husband would not be a necessary party aside from the marriage relation.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of June, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.
