

CHAPTER VI.

An Act to regulate the apportionment of the Current School Funds of the State and their payment by the State Treasurer.

March 5, 1869.

- SECTION 1.** Superintendent of Public Instruction shall transmit to State Auditor a certified copy of each semi-annual apportionment.
2. State Auditor to draw a warrant on State Treasurer, on the receipt of said certified copy for the amount due each county named in said copy and transmit the same.
3. Annual appropriation of school funds.
4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Duty of State Superintendent.

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the state superintendent of public instruction, when he shall make a semi-annual apportionment of the current school funds of the state as required by law, forthwith to transmit to the state auditor a certified copy of such apportionment.

Duty of State Auditor.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the state auditor, when he shall receive a certified copy of any semi-annual apportionment, as provided in section one (1) of this act, forthwith to draw a warrant on the state treasurer payable to the order of the treasurer of each county named in the said copy of the state superintendent, and for the amount due such county, and transmit the same to the county treasurer.

Appropriation of school funds.

SEC. 3. There is hereby annually appropriated out of the moneys in the state treasury, belonging to the general school fund, a sum of money equal the amount of the current school funds due the common schools of the state, and agreeably to law apportioned among the several counties by the state superintendent of public instruction.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its approval.
