

CHAPTER LXVI.

Feb'y 27, 1869. *An Act to amend Section sixteen of title one of Chapter eighty-one of the General Statutes, relating to Foreclosures of Mortgages.*

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section sixteen (16), Title one (1), of Chapter eighty-one (81) of the General Statutes. Court may restrain the commission of waste on property under mortgage until the time allowed for redemption.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section sixteen of title one of chapter eighty-one of the general statutes, is amended by adding thereto the following: Until the expiration of the time allowed for redemption, the court, or a judge thereof in vacation, may restrain the commission of waste on the property, by order granted with or without notice, on application of the mortgagee, purchaser or creditor having a lien on such property.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
