

CHAPTER LXIX.

An Act to amend Section two hundred and eight, of Chapter sixty-six, of the General Statutes, relating to challenging jurors in civil actions. Feb'y 24, 1869.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section two hundred and eight (208) of Chapter sixty six (66) of the General Statutes. Parties may challenge jurors—when to join challenge.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section two hundred and eight, of chapter sixty-six of the general statutes, is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

SEC. 208. Either party may challenge the jurors, but when there are several parties on either side, they shall join in a challenge before it can be made; the challenges are to the panel and individual jurors as in criminal actions except that there can be but three peremptory challenges on each side.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
