

CHAPTER X.

An Act to amend Section three, of Chapter four, of the Charter of the City of St. Cloud, approved March sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight. March 1, 1869.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section three (3) of Chapter four (4) of the Session Laws of 1868. Amount of license for dealers in spirituous liquors—when license to terminate.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the first proviso in first subdivision of section three, chapter four, of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, being an act to incorporate the city of St. Cloud, be amended so as to read as follows: *Provided*, That no license for the dealing in spirituous, vinous or fermented liquors, shall be less than twenty-five dollars a year, and that all licenses shall terminate on the second Tuesday of May in each year. Amount of license—when to terminate.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
