

## CHAPTER CII.

*An Act to change the boundaries of the School District of the village of Oronoco, Olmsted County*

March 2, 1869.

SECTION 1. Description of territory detached from the school district of Oronoco—  
placed under the control of Board of County Commissioners of said  
county.

2. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The territory described as the west one-half of the southwest quarter of section number four (4), the east three-fourths of section number five (5), the northeast quarter of section number eight (8), the west half of section number nine (9), the north half of the northwest quarter and the northeast quarter of section number sixteen (16), and the southwest quarter of section number nineteen (19), all in township number one hundred and eight (108) north, of range number fourteen (14) west, in the county of Olmsted, and embraced within the limits of the school district of the village of Oronoco, organized under the provisions of an act entitled "An act to organize a board of education for the village of Oronoco," approved March first, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, be and the same is hereby detached from the said district and placed under the control and supervision of the board of county commissioners of the said county of Olmsted, and subject to the action of the said board, under the statutes relating to common schools.

Part of Oronoco school district placed under control of county commissioners.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
