

interest becoming due on the maturity of said bonds, and such levy shall forthwith be transmitted by the clerks of said board to the county auditor, whose duty it shall be year by year to place upon the tax rolls the proportion of such levy assigned thereto, which taxes therefore be collected with other taxes.

To be submitted  
to legal voters.

SEC. 10. This act shall be submitted to the legal voters of said Lenora School District for their adoption or rejection at a meeting called for that purpose, in the same manner as provided by law for the calling of special meetings, and no bonds shall be issued until it shall have been adopted by a majority of the votes at said meeting.

When act to  
take effect.

SEC. 11. This act shall be in force after its adoption by said district.

#### CHAPTER CIV.

*An Act to locate, survey and establish a State Road from Jackson, in Jackson County, to Madelia, in Watonwan County.*

March 5, 1869.

- SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed to locate, survey and establish said road.
2. Where and when Commissioners to meet—vacancy, how filled.
  3. Commissioners may employ surveyor, &c.—compensation.
  4. How expenses of locating said road to be defrayed.
  5. Damages sustained, how ascertained.
  6. Commissioners to file plat of road.
  7. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Commissioners  
appointed.

SECTION 1. That Hiram S. Bailey, B. W. Ashley and W. C. Rhoads are hereby appointed commissioners to locate, survey and establish a state road from Jackson, in Jackson county, to Madelia, in Watonwan county.

SEC. 2. The commissioners shall meet in Jackson on any day subsequent to the passage of this act that may be agreed on by them, or a majority of them, and proceed to discharge their duties under this act; and if any of said commissioners appointed under this act, shall be unable from any cause to perform the duties imposed by this act, he shall have power to appoint a substitute, who shall have the same authority, when so appointed, as one of the commissioners named in this act.

When and where to meet—vacancy, how filled.

SEC. 3. Said Commissioners are hereby authorized to employ in locating said road two chainmen one axeman, and one surveyor; *provided*, said commissioners, chainmen and axeman shall not receive more than two dollars and fifty cents per day, nor the surveyor more than four dollars per day, for services rendered by virtue of this act.

May employ surveyor, &c.—compensation.

SEC. 4. The expense of locating said road shall be paid by the counties through or in which said road may pass, in proportion to the distance it may run in each county.

How expenses to be defrayed.

SEC. 5. It shall be the duty of such commissioners to appraise the damages sustained by each owner of land through which said road may pass; and in case any one shall feel himself aggrieved by such appraisal, he may appeal to the county commissioners of his county at any time within thirty days after such appraisal, and the said county commissioners shall, at their next annual meeting, hear and determine said appeal and decide the same as they shall deem just.

Damages, how ascertained.

SEC. 6. Said commissioners shall on or before the first day of September next, file an accurate plat of said road in the office of the register of deeds in each county in which said road may run, and thereafter said road shall be deemed established.

To file plat of road.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.

Approved March 5, 1869.
