

## CHAPTER CXVI.

*An Act to amend and continue the act entitled "An act granting Carmie P. Garlick the right to establish and maintain a ferry across the Saint Croix River." March 9, 1869.*

SECTION 1. The right to establish and maintain said ferry is hereby continued in full force.

2. The rights and powers conferred upon Carmie P. Garlick are hereby continued and vested in David White.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That all and singular the provisions of the legislative assembly of the territory of Minnesota, entitled "An act granting to Carmie P. Garlick the right to establish and maintain a ferry across the Saint Croix river," approved March third, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-five, be and the same are hereby continued in full force, and the same are contined to said corporation, his successors and assigns, in all respects, except only in so far as the same are modified, amended or changed by the provisions of this act.

SEC. 2. That the rights and power enforced upon Carmie P. Garlick and his successors and assigns, be and the same are hereby continued to and vested in David White, the successor in interest of said corporation, his associates, successors or assigns, so invested with rights, franchises and privileges, shall continue with the same privileges and power conferred that are contained in the act to which this is an amendment, and be subject to the same penalties, for the term of fifteen years from and after the third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy.
