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CHAPTER CXXXI.

*An Act to authorize the Trustees of the German Methodist Episcopal Church of Shakopee to sell and convey certain real estate therein named.*

March 3, 1869.

SECTION 1. Trustees of said church authorized to sell and convey certain real estate.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That Harry A. Frank, Erenst Blume, Christ. Heins, Henry Mueller and Frederick Alswede, trustees of the "German Methodist Episcopal Church of Shakopee," be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey to the purchaser by good and sufficient conveyance, the northeast quarter of the block in "Shakopee City" designated on the recorded plat thereof as "reserved for churches," and to use the proceeds of the sale thereof for the benefit of said church corporation.

Trustees may sell certain real estate.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
