

bonds, which taxes shall be levied and collected in the same manner as other city taxes in and for said city are by law required to be levied and collected. And the proceeds of all taxes authorized by this act, shall be paid over to the city treasurer of said city, to be by him applied in payment of the principal and interest of said bonds, and for no other purpose whatever.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the governor.

CHAPTER XXVI.

Feb'y 19, 1869. *An Act to amend an act to legalize the plat of the town of Albert Lea, and conveyances made in reference thereto, approved March fourth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.*

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section three (3) of Chapter forty-two (42) of Special Laws of 1863. What to be deemed a complete and lawful plat of said town—when record may be received as evidence in the courts of this State.
2. Extension of time to perfect title granted.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section three of an act approved March fourth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, entitled an act to legalize the town plat of Albert Lea, and conveyances made in reference thereto, is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

What deemed a lawful plat—when record may be received as evidence.

(Sec. 3.) That said certified copy of the town plat of Albert Lea, together with all the certificates thereon including the acknowledgments and certificates, as provided in this act, shall for all intents and purposes, be taken and deemed to be a complete and lawful plat of said town,

as though the same had been laid out, platted, certified, acknowledged and recorded, in strict conformity to the provisions of the statutes, relating thereto, which were in force at the time said plat was made, and such record and all certified copies thereof shall be taken and received in all courts in this state, as competent evidence of the contents of said plat. *Provided however*, That whenever there purports to have been any vacation of streets, alleys or other parts of said town, as shown by said certified plot, and the records of the court vacating the same, or by any act of the legislature of this state purporting to vacate any portion of said plot, such vacations are by this act recognized and confirmed, saving and excepting so much of Elizabeth and Newton streets which lie north of Clark street, and running to the water's edge of Fountain Lake, so called. *Provided further*, That the acknowledging of said plot as herein provided by any one of the proprietors as aforesaid, or his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, shall have the effect of legalizing the same as herein provided, to the extent of his interest therein, whether the plat be acknowledged by the remaining proprietors or not.

SEC. 2. That the time allowed by section one of the act to which this is amendatory for the parties therein described, to acknowledge and perfect the plot of said town, is hereby extended until the first day of January, A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy.

Time extended

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage.
