

CHAPTER XCIII.

March 4, 1869.

An Act empowering the County Commissioners of Dodge County, in the State of Minnesota, to correct any irregularities and delinquencies in joint school number ninety-seven, composed of parts of the Counties of Dodge and Goodhue.

SECTION 1. County Commissioners of Dodge County empowered to correct all delinquencies in the returns and cause the same to be extended upon the tax duplicate of 1868.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Powers and duties of commissioners of Dodge county.

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Dodge county are hereby empowered to correct any and all delinquencies in the returns of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, from the union school district number ninety-seven, composed of parts of the counties of Dodge and Goodhue, and cause to be extended upon the tax duplicate of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, the tax which it shall appear has been legally voted by said union school district upon the taxable property of said school district.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from its passage.
