#### CHAPTER CIV.

*An Act to appropriate money for the support of the Institute for the Deaf and Dumb, and for the Blind.* March 1, 1870.

SECTION 1. Annual appropriation for the Institute for the Deaf and Dumb, and the Blind—  
in what amount—how drawn—how expended.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of fifteen thousand dollars annually, commencing with the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy, for the support of the Institute for the Deaf and Dumb, and for the Blind, at Faribault. The same to be paid on warrants drawn by the president of the board for the Deaf and Dumb, and the Blind, and countersigned by the secretary thereof. Upon the presentation of such warrants to the state auditor he shall forthwith draw warrants on the state treasurer for the amount named in the warrants of the said president and secretary not exceeding in all the said sum of fifteen thousand dollars per annum. And the money drawn upon said warrants shall be expended under the direction of the board for the Deaf and Dumb, and the Blind, as provided by law, and for the support of the said Institute for the Deaf and Dumb, and the Blind. Annual appropriation—amount—how drawn—how expended.
