CHAPTER CXI.

March 4, 1870. An Act to appropriate money for certain purpose therein named.

BEGTION 1. Appropriation for repairing and furnishing Governor's office.;
When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation for furnishing governor's office.

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred eighty-three dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the hands of the state treasurer, not otherwise appropriated, for purposes hereinafter named, to wit: For plastering governor's office and smoothing walls for inside window blinds for the same; for carpeting for the same; for wall paper and oil cloths and for furniture for other offices; said money to be expended under the direction of the governor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to take and after its passage.
