

Twentieth—For the salary of the clerk of the supreme court, eight hundred dollars (\$800.)

Twenty-first—For the salary of the reporter of the supreme court, six hundred dollars (\$600.)

Twenty-second—For the payment of per diem, mileage and incidental expenses of officers and members of the twelfth session of the legislature, including all sums ordered paid by either or both houses thereof, the sum of five thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXIV.

March 4, 1870.

An Act to appropriate money for the salary of the Clerk of the Adjutant General.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for salary of Clerk in the Adjutant General's office.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation for salary of clerk of adjutant general.

SECTION 1. That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, not otherwise appropriated, to Hugo Petzold, for salary as clerk in the adjutant general's office, from January first to March fifteenth, one thousand eight hundred and seventy.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
