

CHAPTER CXVII.

An Act to reimburse the County of Dakota for money expended in taking care of indigent insane persons.

March 1, 1870.

SECTION 1. Appropriation to reimburse the county of Dakota for the care of indigent insane persons—what amount.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of seven hundred and eighty-two dollars and fifty cents, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury of the state not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse the county of Dakota the amount paid by said county for taking care of and supporting Bridget Hersey and Bridget Walsh indigent insane persons during the years one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six and one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, and that the state auditor draw a warrant on the state treasurer in favor of said county for said amount.
