

CHAPTER LXIX.

An Act to amend Section Two Hundred and Seventy-Eight, Chapter Sixty-Six, of the General Statutes, and provide for the exemption of necessary seed grain from attachment or levy and sale on execution. Feb'y 11, 1870.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section Two Hundred and Seventy-Eight (275) of Chapter Sixty-Six (66) of the General Statutes. Exemption of necessary seed grain from attachment or levy and sale on execution.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two hundred and seventy-eight, of chapter sixty-six, of the general statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto at the end thereof the following:

Tenth—Necessary seed grain for the actual personal use of the debtor for one season, to be selected by him, not however in any case to exceed the following kinds and amounts respectively, viz: Fifty bushels of wheat, fifty bushels of oats, five bushels of potatoes and one bushel of corn.

Seed grain exempt from levy or sale on execution.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
