## CHAPTER LXXIII.

Feb'y 10, 1870.

An Act to amend Section Nine, of Chapter Seventy-Eight, of the General Statutes, relating to Fines and Forfeitures.

Secrets 1. Amendment to Section Nine (9) of Chapter Seventy-Eight (78) of the General Statutes. Fines and forfeitures not specially appropriated by law to be paid into the county treasury.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section nine, of chapter seventy-eight, of the general statutes, be amended so as to read as follows:

Fines, &c., to be paid into the county treasury.

Sec. 9. Fines and forfeitures not specially granted or appropriated by law shall be paid into the treasury of the county where the same are incurred; and whenever any property, real or personal, is forfeited to the state, or to any officer for its use, an action for the recovery of such property, alleging the grounds of the forfeiture, may be brought by the proper officer in the district court of any county where such property may be.
