

CHAPTER LXXXVI.

An Act to detach Jackson, Noble and Rock counties from Martin County for judicial purposes, and establish a term of District Court in said Jackson County, and attach Noble and Rock counties to Jackson for judicial purposes.

March 7, 1870.

- SECTION 1.** Detached from certain counties for judicial purposes.
2. Time of holding term of District Court in Jackson County.
 3. Detached from and attached to certain county for judicial purposes.
 4. All writs, recognizances, etc., deemed to be returnable to the term of said Court.
 5. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the county of Jackson be and the same is hereby detached from the county of Martin for judicial purposes. Jackson county detached for judicial purposes.

SEC. 2. There shall be held in the said county of Jackson a regular term of the district court on the fourth Tuesday in October in each year. Time of holding court in Jackson county.

SEC. 3. The counties of Noble and Rock are hereby detached from the county of Martin for judicial purposes and attached to the county of Jackson for judicial purposes. Counties attached to Jackson for judicial purposes.

SEC. 4. All judicial proceedings now pending in and all writs and recognizances returnable to the district court in the county of Martin from the said counties of Jackson, Noble and Rock shall be made pending in and returnable to the district court in Jackson county. Where writs, etc., made returnable.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
