CHAPTER LXXXIX.

An Act to arganize the County of Cottonwood.

March 3, 1870.

SECTION 1. Commissioners to be appointed to locate county scat of said county-by whom appointed-how county seat may be changed.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the governor take such action (under existing laws) as may be necessary to organize the county of Cottonwood, and appoint three disinterested persons, commissioners to locate the county seat of said county, Commissioners to locate county seat the place designated by said commissioners, or a majority —how appointed —how county of them, when reported to the governor, shall remain the seat changed. seat of justice of said county until confirmed or changed, by a vote of the legal voters of said county, when submitted to them in accordance with the provisions of the constitution of the state of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. This act to take effect and be in force from When and to take and after its passage.
